The day concluded with honouring of 4 community members from local First Nation Communities and Pow wow Dancing Demonstrations and Round dancing. The day's events were well attended, and the Indigenous themed dinner that was served was delicious.

This site wide initiative was to encourage people to exert any negative energy in a positive way, while also providing Indigenous ways of balancing physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual stresses in a good way.

CREATING SAFER WORKSPACES FOR WOMEN

Moose Hide Campaign Day Live Stream events, which included day breaking ceremony, fasting ceremony, fast breaking ceremony, walk and other Moose Hide Campaign Day Events live streamed from Victoria, BC. Elder lead gender specific support Groups; Medicine Wheels Teachings with George and April Longman, and a support Group with Elder's from Fishing Lake First Nation. Each week there was a Unity Walk, outside on the Jansen Walking Trails.
